

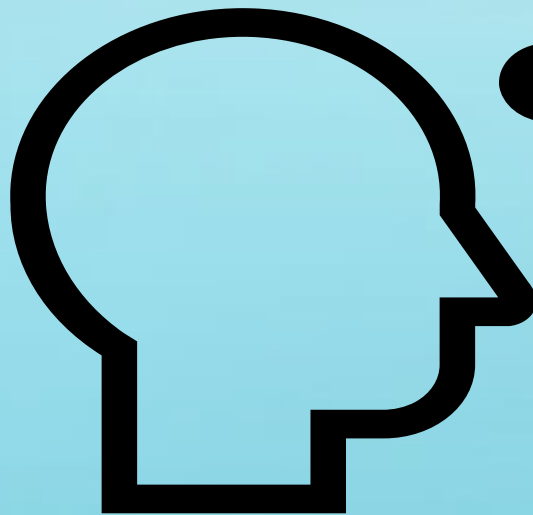

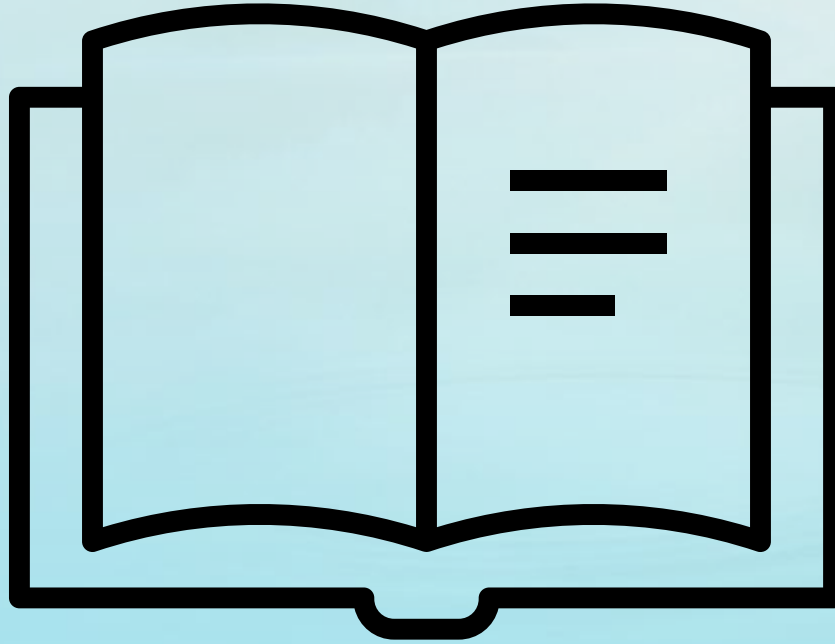


Faithfulness is about relationship!
